Driver/Residential Construction Assistant needed for Habitat for Humanity of San Antonio, a large non-profit, single family home builder. Position duties include driving a pick-up truck, hooking and unhooking bumper-pull or gooseneck trailers, safe-driving of pick-up pulling a trailer loaded with construction materials, loading and unloading materials, assisting in our warehouse and assisting with our construction activities on-site.

- 2+ years experience as a driver pulling a loaded trailer;
- Must have and maintain a Texas drivers' license and a good driving record.
- Construction experience helpful, but not required – we can train you!
- Team oriented with good people skills;
- Good oral communication skills;
- Good at producing timely paperwork, adherence to policies and procedures, and time management;
- Self-starter and ability to work with minimal oversight;
- Must have a positive attitude with a good sense of humor;
- Must pass a background check and drug screening;
- This position will work on an active construction site so must have strong physical and mental capabilities including the ability to load and unload, lift and carry 50 lbs or more, must be able to stand, walk, squat, climb stairs and ladders, and be on your feet for extended periods of the day each and every day. Must have good manual dexterity with fine motor control of both hands and fingers along with other physical and mental abilities that are needed to effectively work on and traverse a large scale construction site.

This is a full-time, hourly position with decent pay and time over 40 hours per week paid at time-and-a-half. This is a 5 day a week position (normally) but work shift may vary to meet the needs of the organization from Monday thru Saturday as follows:

- Hours are generally 6:45 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. but may be altered based on work activities. Some days may start earlier, some days may end later.
- Occasional Sunday work if we have a special building event at a Church during or after their Sunday services (we call these Joshua Builds and expect approx 5 this year).
- Days and hours are reasonable, but selected candidate will be expected to work the days and hours as needed to accomplish our goals.
- Non-smoker.
