How to Use: A great way to get the youth of your congregation involved with serving is to have a Habitat-themed VBS. These ideas can be added to your existing VBS plans or stand-alone to keep kids learning about how important service is and also about the great need for affordable housing in San Antonio.

Construction-themed obstacle course
LEGO or Jenga Building tournament
Pin the nail on the hammer
Gingerbread house build or graham cracker house build
Fill the tool bag relay race
Nuts and bolts pretzel snack kits
Build a house-shaped bank and collect donations to “Make Change Happen”
Cardboard/tent city build or lock-in
Have an ice cream party and make “Concrete Sundaes”
Construction cone ring toss
Paintbrush water splash
Making “Welcome Home” cards for homebuyer families
Creating stepping stones for their garden
Discovering your family tree
Creating family photo frames
Stud decorating
Bible points can include helping others, providing hope and love, and building each other up
Studying the Sermon on the Mount and how it tells us to serve others
Learning how to pray using LEGOS
Learning about the “blueprints” for a faith-focused family

Let these ideas inspire you to be creative. Change them up to match the age group that you are working with. Enlist older youth to assist and teach – and they will learn along the way too.
