Home Center Volunteers, 18 and up - Did you know that our three Home Center Stores are the reason that 100% of all donations go right into Habitat's building program? So come and help us on Mondays through Saturdays stocking shelves, putting together cabinets, cleaning up and helping our customers.

Office Assistants, 18 and up - Want to help, but need to be inside? Help with general office tasks such as sorting, filing, preparing communications, putting together packets for sponsors and more. Flexible hours, Mondays- Fridays.

Wrecking Crew, 18 and up - Join our staff as we travel to locations around the city and remove fixtures from homes or businesses for resale in our Habitat Home Centers. This helps local families keep remodeling costs down and gives us access to inventory that, when removed properly, can be sold and used again.

On Site Construction, 14 and up - Construction crews are the heart of Habitat's ministry. No previous experience is necessary! We build year-round, Tuesdays through Saturdays. Each site has a House Leader to instruct you and provide you with all the materials and tools necessary to complete the variety of tasks scheduled for that day, 7:45 am – 3:00 pm. Get hands-on experience and learn some new things all while serving those in need in our own community. You can schedule as an individual or come out as a group.

Child Care Provider, ages vary - Help our on-site volunteers by offering childcare at your home or at your congregation for kids while parents help with construction. We can help you plan fun Habitat-themed adventures for the day.

Database Updating, 16 and up - Help keep our faith contact list current so we can reach more congregations and grow our partnerships. You will search the web and maybe make some calls from your home or our offices as you update our database.

Event and Party Planners, 16 and up - Recruit and coordinate donations of music, food, gifts, and more for our home dedication or other events.

Lunch Provider, all ages - On Fridays and Saturdays, you can help keep the energy up on site by providing and serving lunch to a house full of hungry Habitat volunteers. We ask for 30 healthy and hearty meals that include all paper products, drinks, and desserts. All ages can help with the collecting, coordinating, preparation, delivery, and serving of the meal. This is a great way for families with younger children to serve.



Welcome Home Cards, all ages - Make welcome home cards for families to be delivered on a dedication day. This is a great way to let families know that they are loved.

Table Decorations, all ages - Get creative and make tabletop and other decorations for events that Habitat has throughout the year. This is a great way to get crafty and help Habitat celebrate and share our mission.

Filmmakers and Photographers, all ages - Document build days and events. We use photographs and videos to reach out to new people and congregations and to build up our support in the community. Help us put our best face forward by sharing your talents with us.

Plan a Habitat Fundraiser, all ages - You can reach out to your family, your school, your office, scout groups, sports teams and more to raise funds for Habitat homes. There are lots of fun and simple ideas available here. [Fundraising Ideas and Tools](#).

Event Set-Up, all ages - Set up and take down tables, chairs, distribute handouts, etc. for our FIAT luncheons and other events throughout the year.

Musicians, all ages - Individuals or groups are needed throughout the year to perform at our house dedications or other special events. Help us set a celebratory mood.

Model Makers, all ages - Create a professional-looking 3D model of our home in scale. Habitat will provide the plans and you decide what materials to use. Churches use these all the time to help them recruit volunteers and collect donations.

Mission Market Volunteers, all ages - Set up and manage a Habitat table to share information and sign up volunteers at your church, your school or other community events.

Prayer Team, all ages - Join Habitat's Prayer Team and receive prayers throughout the year to help keep Habitat's ministry focused on God. Prayers are sent by email throughout the year.

Social Media Supporter, all ages - Be a Habitat super supporter and like us and share us on our social media pages. Share pictures of you volunteering or learning about Habitat and the need for affordable housing in our city. Share on your pages, then tag us on Facebook, Twitter, and Instagram.

Plan a Habitat Spirit Day, all ages - Plan a day or week full of Habitat themed events and activities. You can do this at school, at the office, with your team or group. This is a great way to inform folks about Habitat and get them excited to help or give. We have lots of activity ideas we can share!
